**Graduate Student Training**



Fraser Child & Family Center, a division of Fraser, offers training opportunities to graduate students at the master and doctoral levels for practicum or internship in psychology, neuropsychology, counseling, social work, marriage and family therapy as well as the rehab disciplines of speech, occupational therapy and music therapy. Fraser is a non-profit agency which provides services to individuals with developmental, emotional and behavioral disabilities in areas of mental health, rehabilitation, education and housing.

**Fraser Child & Family Center** offers the following programs:

**Day Treatment**

**Fraser Autism Day Treatment Program:** Three hour day treatment program for preschool aged children with autism spectrum disorders including group skills training and group therapy as well as case management.

**Pre-school Day Treatment:** Three hour program for preschool aged children, including individual and group skills training and group therapy as well as case management.

**Adolescent Day Treatment:** Three hour program for adolescents including individual and group skills and group therapy.

**Outpatient Services (individual, group, and family skills and therapies for children, adolescents and their families)**

**Fraser Child & Family Mental Health Program:** Provides mental health services to children with emotional and/or behavioral disorders and their families including: diagnostic assessments; psychological testing including cognitive, personality and behavioral; individual, group and family therapies.

**Fraser Autism Program:** Provides outpatient mental health services to children diagnosed with an autism spectrum diagnosis, including: individual and family skills training and therapy.

**Fraser Neuropsychology Program:** Offers diagnostic neuropsychological evaluations to children and adolescents with learning disorders, traumatic brain injuries, and other neurobehavioral disorders.

**Fraser Rehabilitation Program:** Offers evaluation and treatment to children with speech and language disorders, sensory disorders, and developmental disorders.

Practicum and intern graduate students in mental health may gain experience providing individual, group and family therapy and skills training through our day treatment programs and outpatient diagnostic evaluations and therapies subject to their training and experience. Fraser Child & Family Center provides mental health services at the main site located at 3333 University Avenue S.E. in Minneapolis and at three other locations: Day treatment program in collaboration with Minneapolis Public Schools at the Wilder School in South Minneapolis; Collaboration with Ramsey County Head Start at the Bigelow Building in St. Paul; and a new site in Coon Rapids, Anoka County. Supervision is provided by licensed professionals and the agency offers multiple opportunities for consultation and supervision by others on its multidisciplinary staff.

Students receiving training and supervision in the rehab disciplines gain experience providing assessments and therapy in speech and language therapy and occupational therapy.
